
Accessing ALEKS Progress Pie Chart:

All students should sign into ALEKS using their Chromebook. Here are the 5 steps to access your account:


1) Sign In Using Google Chromebook and click on "Google Account"




If your account doesn't sign in, remember that to sign into your Chromebook and accounts use:

- First Initial, Middle Initial, Last Name, Year of Graduation (example: amharris2035)
- Use Hp\$ and your lunch code for the 5 numbers (example: Hp\$12345)






3) Scroll down to find the McGraw Hill Icon (colored red) and select that.



4) You will see "active" or "archived" classes – please click on "Archived" classes.



5) Here you will select either – Continue Knowledge Check or Continue Learning Path!



The above picture shows Continue Knowledge Check, but some may still be in their Learning Path.

This should have you then creating a continuous stream of just what you are "ready to handle skills" in your particular learning pathway.
